

DISPLAY 26-7 Clinical Scenario for Traction Injury to the Long Thoracic Nerve

A 39-year-old female homemaker injured her long thoracic nerve from constantly carrying a diaper bag and her 25-lb toddler on her left side. The MMT grade of her serratus anterior at the time of initial examination is 3–/5. Her functional goals are to be able to perform activities of daily living and instrumental activities of daily living of a full-time homemaker. She is not involved in any upper extremity sports or recreational activities.

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
